The first 2 items MUST BE VERIFIED at your 1st and 2nd appointments. If they are NOT verified, we are NOT allowed to prepare your taxes.

ITEMS TO BRING (Copies are strongly encouraged)

- Photo ID (driver's license or other government issued photo ID) of you and your spouse, if filing jointly
 - _____ Social Security Cards for <u>EVERY</u> person on your tax return
- Birthdates of <u>EVERYONE</u> on your tax return
